Jennifer Tallman graduated from Lakehead University in Forestry before moving to Cochrane, in Northeastern Ontario. She started her career at the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry and went on to work directly in woodlands operations, certification and forest management. Jennifer joined EACOM Timber Corporation in 2015 as Forest Planning Coordinator and was promoted to Chief Forester, Ontario in 2017 – the first woman to hold this key position at the company. "The award comes as both a surprise and honour. Over my career, I have had the privilege of being supported by great mentors, most of whom were male. They provided the opportunities and encouragement for me to grow and expand my horizon," recalled Tallman. "As more and more young women enter the field of forestry and natural resource management, I am excited to see a network of female mentors stepping up in the workplace and online to support this next generation of leaders."
